<u>ORDER:-</u>

In the reference third read above, the EFS&T department has stated that, Red Sanders (PterocarpusSantalinus) is exclusive to the forests of Seshachalam, Veligonda, Lankamala and Palakonda Hill Ranges of Andhra Pradesh and distributed in the districts of Kadapa, Chittoor, Nellore, Prakasam and Kurnool over an area 5.16 lakh. There is enormous pressure of smuggling on Red Sanders due to its demand in the international market. There is rampant smuggling and felling of Red Sanders trees in the districts of Chittoor, Kadapa, Nellore and Kurnool in spite of various steps taken by the Forest and Police Departments. The Red Sanders logs are being cut by wood cutters employed by organized gangs of smugglers. After the logs are cut, smugglers are transferring the Red Sanders wood to various storage points and are further moved clandestinely out of the country. The wood has great demand in South East Asia, China and Japan.

- Home Department in the reference fourth read above has informed that in the recent past, several violent incidents have occurred, where the Forest officials intercepting the wood cutters or illicit transporters were physically assaulted, killing two Forest personnel in one incident. Hence, the Department has stated that there is a need for Red Sanders Anti-smuggling Task Force to be effective against the seasoned, crude and daring smugglers hailing mainly from the neighboring states and requested for sanction of necessary posts for staffing the Task Force.
- 3. After careful examination of the proposal and in order to ensure effective protection of the Red Sanders' forests, the Government hereby order for creation of 463(Four Hundred and Sixty Three only) posts as mentioned in the annexure appended to this order to establish the armed Joint Task Force consisting of Police and Forest personnel, called the Red Sanders Anti-Smuggling Task Force (RSASTF).
- 4 The RSASTF shall function under the command and administrative control of the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) or any other senior forest officer specifically designated by him in this regard under the supervision of Inspector General of Police, Rayalaseema Region for operations and other related matters.
- 5 The entire staff of RSASTF except the posts on contractual basis shall be on deputation from the Police and Forest Departments by drawing capable and competent staff after screening.

- Deployment into the force will depend on the willingness and suitability to be decided by the Heads of Police Force and Forest Force jointly. Any one of them may berepatriated to the parent unit anytime without any notice, if he is found unsuitable. The Head of Police Department (HOPD) and Head of Forest Force (HOFF) will apportion the above sanctioned strength amongst various deputation lending units under their control on the basis of need and administrative convenience. Correspondingly, the HOPD and HOFF will arrange to augment the deputation reserve of lending units class/category wise for the purpose of promotions/ recruitment in the respective units.
- 7 The staff deployed in the RSASTF will get a Special Allowance at the Rate of 30% of Pay during their tenure with RSASTF.
- 8 EFS&T and Home Departments shall take further action for formulating the operational and functional guidelines of the above Task Force.
